Terms & Conditions Of Rental

Renting An Instrument

All rental prices shown on the Instrument Rental Price List are for 3 months rental inclusive. The 3 month rental fee is payable in advance. A one off delivery/admin fee of £15 will be added to your first rental payment if the rental agreement is being administered by post.

When the rental period expires

At the end of your rental period, you have the choice of purchasing the instrument, re-renting the instrument for another 3 month period, or returning the instrument to us. Although out of courtesy we do sometimes send reminders, it is the obligation of the hirer to ensure the instrument is returned, re-rented or purchased by the due date shown on your rental agreement.

If You Are Late in Renewing Your Agreement

Failure to re-new the agreement, or return or purchase an instrument before the due date shown on your agreement will result in a further rental charge being deducted from your credit/debit card. If the amount to purchase the instrument is lower than the rental fee, we will charge the lower of the two sums. All rental payments are non-refundable.

Purchasing the instrument you are renting

You are entitled to purchase the instrument that you are renting at a discounted price. We will deduct up to the value of the first 6 months consecutive rental payments from the normal selling price of the instrument if you decide to purchase it.

Spreading the cost of purchasing the instrument

Subject to status, you may be able to spread the cost of purchasing your rented instrument over 24 or 36 monthly payments. This finance is provided by Clydesdale Financial Services, and a credit check will need to be done. Written details are available on request. APR on finance is 19.9%.

Purchasing a different instrument to the one you are renting

Under some circumstances, you may wish to purchase a different instrument to the one that you are renting. Unfortunately we are unable to deduct your first 6 months rental payments from any other instrument except the one you are renting ***unless the instrument you are renting was already "ex-rental"***.

Loss or damage caused to an instrument whilst in your care

The hirer is liable for the instrument whilst it is on rental. Any loss or damage caused whilst the instrument is on rental is the responsibility of the hirer and instruments are not covered by Bonners insurance policies.

Insurance

Many household contents policies cover our instruments whilst they are on rental, but we strongly recommend you contact your insurer to clarify this. For true peace of mind, we recommend you use a dedicated musical instrument insurer such as Allianz Cornhill who can be contacted on 0870 2400 303.
